

Understanding God: The Holy Spirit is God

Exo 3:14 God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

1. He has divine names.

Peter referred to Him as being God (Acts 5:3-4), "the Lord is the Spirit," and the "Spirit is the Lord" (2 Cor 3:17-18), He indwell His people whose bodies are referred to as "the temple of God" (1 Cor. 3:16), His identification with the divine personal name "LORD" (Jeremiah 31:31-34 with Hebrews 10:15-18; Judges 15:14 with 16:20), and with the generic name "God" (see Matt 12:28 with Luke 11:20)

2. He has the attributes of God.

Life (Rom 8:2; John 3:5-6); eternity (Heb. 9:14); omnipresence (Ps 139:7; 1 Cor. 6:19); omnipotence (Job 33:4; Ps. 104:30; Gen 1:2); omniscience (I Cor. 2:10-11; John 16:13); truthfulness (John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13; 1 John 2:27; 5:60); holiness (Rom 1:4); righteousness (Rom 8:4); grace (Heb. 10:29, love (Rom. 15:30; 5:5); and sovereignty (1 Cor. 12:11; Acts 10:19-20)

3. He does the work of God.

creation (Gen. 1:2; Ps 33:6; Job 26:13); inspired the prophets (2 Pet 1:21); brought about the conception of Jesus' sinless human nature (Luke 1:35); and produces the new birth of gospel believers (John 3:3-8)

4. He is listed with the other Persons of God

(Matt 28:18 and 1 John 5:17)
